Here's a list of items that the Dixie Car Club collects to send our troops in Iraq. Approximately \$200 is spent in postage monthly. Any donations or contributions towards that amount is appreciated. The Dixie Car Club is a non-profit organization and contributions are tax deductible. Checks can be made to the "Dixie Car Club". Gateway Church members can bring items on Sunday and George take care of them. This is an ongoing event - not just a one time deal. Contributions are needed on a continuing basis - weekly. Multiple quantities of each item will be split among the individual boxes. No certain quantity can be given as the quantity of boxes varies upon the deployment & return of the various individuals. Any of our Gateway Church members that have a relative in Iraq, let me know and they'll be added to the list.

Please note that summer temperatures go up to 140° - things melt! There is NO PX or Commissary in Iraq. They have no place to shop other than the local markets - which are dangerous. These guys all share everything with each other. What ever goes to one goes to all the others in his unit - Men & Women! Nothing goes to waste - everything is shared.
